Rosa Nera is a squat located at Kasteli district, at the old town of Chania, and since 2004 gives life to a previously abandoned building, owned by the Technical University of Crete. Rosa Nera constitutes a self-organized, open, socio-political space, a community of struggle beyond and against capitalist values and state institutions. Technical University of Crete tries to sell to Hotel Management Company Belvedere Ltd the right to use the occupied building for 25 years and methodically orchestrates its evacuation. They want to turn a centre of struggle to another sweatshop of tourist industry, which seeks to conquer every square metre of the city. But they count their chickens before they are hatched...
